Conditions of Entry

Eligibility to Compete: Open to all registered and financial swimmers, 12yrs and under and 13yrs and over with a competitive membership.

- Learn to Swim: Enter through the Google Form available on the club website.

Entry Fees:

- SNZ Members: \$8 per event
- Learn to swim: \$5 per event (paid into St Paul's Swim Club bank account- Ref: Name & Christmas)

Late entries will be at the Technical Directors' discretion based on lane space availability. Late entry will incur a fee of \$50.00 per swimmer which must be paid into St Paul's Swim Club bank account prior to the start of the meet. Marshalling: will be available at the starting end of the pool.

Scratchings / Withdrawals: Refunds will only be made if a medical certificate is provided to the meet recorder. All refunds are at the discretion of the technical director. No refunds for any withdrawals before or during the meet without a medical certificate.

Relays & Event 14:

These events are free for all swimmers and will be run if numbers permit. Swimmers wishing to take part should report to marshalling when called.

Programme: Initial seeding and the event programme will be circulated on Thursday afternoon following close of entries.

Format:

All events will be swum as Mixed Races. Swimmers with No Times (NT) will be seeded within their age group.

LTS swimmers will compete in separate heats, with hand-timed results provided after each race.

Results from LTS events will not be uploaded to the Swimming New Zealand database.

Officials and Volunteers: The meet will be conducted with trainee officials and will follow Swimming New Zealand competition rules as closely as possible.

Parent volunteers are essential to help run the meet. Please get involved, try different roles, and enjoy supporting our swimmers.
